

FRANTIŠEK PALACKÝ, ANTONÍN BOČEK AND
MORAVIAN SEPARATISM

The main object of this study is to show that the Moravian separatism of the 1830's was engendered by Moravian patriots, and not notably furthered by the Austrian statesman and Moravian patriot Count Anton Friedrich Mitrowsky. The correspondence between the Bohemian Czech František Palacký and the Moravian historian Antonín Boček forms the starting point and essential substance of the study, in which Boček's new documentation of early Moravian history is shown to be linked causally to Moravian separatist tendencies.
