Self-determination of Peoples and National Sovereignty

In this article, the German philosopher presents his legal-political reflections on one of the most controversial topics of modern Bohemian history, the question of the right of self-determination. Without going into the historical context, the author starts from the general question of which rights “nations” or groups of people, who have a consciousness – however developed – of unity and the desire can demand within the European legal historical tradition.
