CROSS CURRENTS IN CENTRAL EUROPE

Notice about a Yearbook

L. Matejka and B. Stolz of the University of Michigan at Ann Arbor have been the editors of Cross Currents. A Yearbook of Central European Culture since 1982. The third, fourth and fifth issues of Cross Currents (1984–1986) contain articles on Czech, Slovak, Polish, Ukrainian, Lithuanian, Hungarian, Austrian, Romanian and Southern Slavic topics, as well as on the Jews who live in this area. Nowhere have the borders of "Central Europe" been delimited, and surprisingly, Germany is not included. The editors place philosophy, religion, literature, theatre, film, fine arts and music under the rubric "culture". The main focus is on the nineteenth and twentieth centuries, particularly the latter.
