

POLISH GOVERNMENT REPORTS FROM 1929 ON JEWISH
ORGANIZATIONS IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA

Jerzy Tomaszewski has published two reports from the Polish Consulate in Moravská Ostrava to the Foreign Ministry in Warsaw. The first document considers the Jewish question in Moravia and Silesia, in particular, the numbers, activities, and the national identity of the Jews of Polish origin. The second discusses the sports organizations of the Maccabi and their relation to Poland. In his introduction, the author demonstrates that Polish interest in the Jewish problems in Moravia-Silesia was connected with the presence of a Polish minority in that region; Warsaw had high hopes for cooperation between Polish and Jewish groups there.
