A FORGOTTEN PŘEMYSLID PRINCESS: NEW QUESTIONS AND RESEARCH RESULTS Bea Lundt

The author has chosen a 1987 German translation of Luisa Muraro's Italianlanguage study, Vilemina und Mayfred, History of a feminist heresy, as the focus of her article. Placing the most recent biography of the little-known daugther of Přemysl Ottokar I and sister of St. Agnes in the context of previous biographical and pertinent social and religious-historical information, she asks how fruitful Munaro's feminist interpretation has proved to be. It appears that the feminist perspective alone is not adequate; it can, however, contribute new aspects to the analysis of medieval spirituality.
