

## RESEARCH PROJECTS ON THE HISTORY OF THE BOHEMIAN LANDS

When, in the past year, prospects arose for the first free contacts between Czech and Slovak historians and their colleagues abroad, the Collegium Carolinum undertook to contribute to the task of satisfying the backlog demand for an exchange of information. Questionnaires concerning present research activities and future projects were mailed to researchers in this field with a view to making available, for all those interested, information about who was working on which subject, and where. Thanks to the cooperation extended by the Historický ústav ČSAV in Prague, the Collegium Carolinum succeeded in finding almost three hundred researchers from Czechoslovakia and from abroad whose work embraces a host of topics. The subjects of research and the names of the researchers have been published in this issue; everyone who is interested in the addresses of those conducting research on a certain subject is invited to forward his request to the Collegium Carolinum.
