HISTORY OF THE BOHEMIAN LANDS: NEW CONDITIONS FOR A FIELD OF RESEARCH

This was the title of a conference at Bad Wiessee in November 1990, which was reported on in Bohemia 31/2 (1991), pp. 379-381. Some of the contributions presented at this conference were published in the Bulletin Historického ústavu ČAV, Nos. 1-5 (Dec. 27, 1990); another four appear in this issue of Bohemia. Ferdinand Seibt's contribution deals with new topics, new sources, and new prospects, and evolves possible frameworks for future international cooperation among the historians of the Bohemian lands; Georg G. Iggers places the question of national history and historical science in the context of contemporary developments in historiography; Harry Hanak and Stanley B. Winters report on developments taking place in Great Britain and the US respectively.
