

“OUR HISTORY”: CZECH AND GERMAN PAST
AS A MATTER OF INTERPRETATION

In March 1994, Collegium Carolinum and the Franz Kafka Society of Prague cooperatively organized a symposium under the title: *“Our History”: Czech And German Past as a Matter of Interpretation*, which took place in Prague.
