A FUTILE PLEA: THE LETTER KÄTHE SPIEGEL SENT TO THE RECTOR OF THE GERMAN CHARLES UNIVERSITY IN PRAGUE OCTOBER 11, 1941

The author seeks to shed some light upon the final months in the life of the Prague German-Jewish historian and women's rights advocate, Käthe Spiegel (1898-1942?). In 1941, Spiegel was deported from Prague to the Ghetto in Łodz. Her fate beyond this point could not be determined. As a documentary supplement, a letter is reprinted which Spiegel addressed to the rector of the German University in Prague, whom she implored to help avoid her imminent deportation.
