

A DOCUMENT OF INTELLECTUAL AND HISTORICAL
SIGNIFICANCE: THE NEWLY-EDITED
CORRESPONDENCE OF BERNARD BOLZANO

For a number of years, the Viennese Academy of Sciences has been preparing a complete edition of the works of Bernard Bolzano. The present report describes the latest volume in this edition, which contains Bolzano's letters. Bolzano's correspondence predominantly features letters to and from members of the so-called Bolzano circle, i.e. Bolzano's pupils, among whom are Josef Dittrich, Michael Josef Fesl, Vinzenz Fiebrich, František Příhonský, Franz Schneider, Anton Slivka, Anton Stoppani, Gregor Zeithammer, Johann August Zimmermann and his son, Robert Zimmermann. In that it adds to our insights into important intellectual currents in Prague and Bohemia before 1848, this collection of letters is a document of eminent significance in both intellectual and biographical regards.
