The edited correspondence of Bernard Bolzano being published as part of the complete edited works already includes nearly all of the letters to Bolzano's family and friends as well as students and colleagues. It is now completed with the letters to and from Michael Josef Fesl, which make up the most substantial part of the preserved correspondence. These letters provide a comprehensive foundation for understanding Bolzano's work and terminology. The correspondence also contributes to unravelling the Bohemian scholar's social and scientific network as well as echoing the political events of the period.
